



## Winter/Spring 2018 ARTLAB Afterschool REGISTRATION PACKET

ARTLAB is designed to support young artists, creatives and makers (ages 12-18) build their artistic practice and individual style while offering exposure to new materials and techniques. Under the guidance of faculty, artists, and NHIA artist-teacher candidates, students will be challenged to step out of their creative comfort zones and explore a theme through various independent and collaborative 2D and 3D projects. This is the perfect opportunity for young artists of all levels to push their artistic boundaries, meet other local teens, gain experience in different mediums and challenge themselves through creative experimentation. ARTLABS end with a pop-up gallery reception for young artists to showcase their work to family and friends.

### *SCHEDULE*

ARTLABS follow a theme over 8 weeks, however students have the flexibility to register for four-week sessions or the full eight weeks. Students can also attend multiple days a week and explore different themes, mini-workshops and studios.

### *OPEN STUDIO (Optional)*

Students have an opportunity for extra “open studio” time before ARTLAB. Students will have access to a wide range of materials including paint, charcoal, clay and more for independent or collaborative artistic creation. Students can use this time to brush up on their technique or work one-on-one with Youth Arts Instructors on new approaches. Snacks are also provided at this time.

### *AREAS OF FOCUS*

ARTLABS guide students through a range of mediums and techniques. All ARTLABS will include instruction around painting, drawing and collage, along with mini-workshops experiences with guest artists. Each four-week session of ARTLAB will include mini workshops in different studios across the NHIA Manchester campus, ranging in photography, printmaking, illustration and more. ### *ART LAB GALLERY RECEPTION*

An integral part of ARTLAB is sharing the young artists' creative experimentation and process with family, friends and the public. Each student is invited to exhibit work in one of two pop up gallery receptions. Sessions 1-2 will be held on Friday, April 13, 6:00pm to 7:00pm and Sessions 3a and 3b will be held on Tuesday, May 15, 7:00pm to 8:00pm and Session 4 will be held on May 10, 7:00 - 8:00pm.
