Would you like to meet and work with other students who are artists and designers like you?

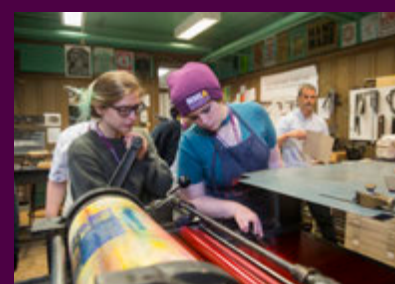
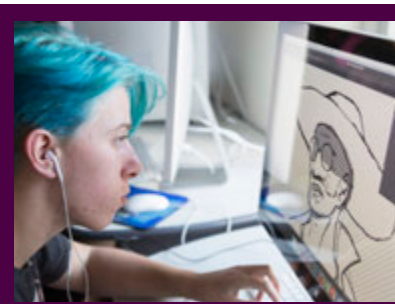

NHIA's Pre-College Summer Art Intensives offer you an inspiring college-level experience allowing you to develop and broaden your skills, understand and use your personal creative voice, and build a professional portfolio of work.

Studio and seminars in each program are taught by NHIA's exceptional undergraduate faculty and visiting artists and leaders in each field. Outside of class, you will work with your peers in the different programs in collaborative and group workshops, participate in presentations and discussions with visiting artists, gain feedback from professional artists in a portfolio review, and enjoy a visit to the beautiful New Hampshire Seacoast.

High school students 15-19 years old are welcome to apply.

APPLICATION

Application Priority Deadline: February 1

Our program fills up quickly. Admitted students whose applications are post-marked by February 1 will get the classes of their choice and be given priority consideration for financial aid. Following the Priority Deadline, preference will be given to applications received by April 1, 2018 or until the program reaches maximum capacity. Financial aid will continue to be awarded as funds remain available. All students must submit the following items to apply:

1. Complete the online application form
2. 3-5 works (images or writing) via Slideroom
3. Personal Essay (300-500 words) via Slideroom. Your essay should address how you will use the experience of Pre-College to benefit your education and the development of your creative ideas. You may submit an artist statement in lieu of an essay
4. Recommendation from 1-2 references, preferably your primary art or writing instructor (this may be submitted through Slideroom; emailed to PreCollege@nhia.edu or be sent hard-copy to the Pre-College team
5. Submit payment for \$30 application

All materials can be sent to NHIA online at nhia.slideroom.com.

EXPENSES

The total cost of the program is \$2,295 including tuition, materials, and room and board. Students should have money available for individual expenses and a weekend field trip.

Note: Applicants that are not accepted into the program will have their application fee refunded.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are merit-based and awarded on an individual basis.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Students live in NHIA's residence halls. NHIA will make room assignments on a first come, first served basis and will make every effort to accommodate your first choice. A bed, dresser, and desk are provided. You will need to provide your own linens. Common areas include a study, kitchen, laundry room, and lounge. Continental breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be served each day. On Sunday, NHIA will serve just brunch and dinner. Vegetarian and gluten-free selections will be offered at each meal. Students with specific food requirements must make their own accommodations.

REGISTRATION

Students are registered on a first come, first served basis. Every effort is made to register the student in their first choice classes.

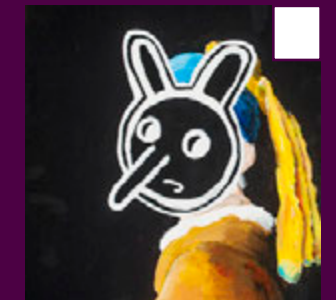
