Our Master of Arts in Teaching Visual Arts (MAT) degree is designed for and run by practicing, professional art educators and artists. The flexible, hybrid curriculum provides a balance of online and face-to-face interaction. Students develop their creative and academic skills, achieving their personal goals and building a career in education. The curriculum of online and on-campus coursework is integrated with early fieldwork in K-12 schools and in NHIA's Youth Arts program--all students complete two semesters of culminating fieldwork in elementary and secondary school placements.

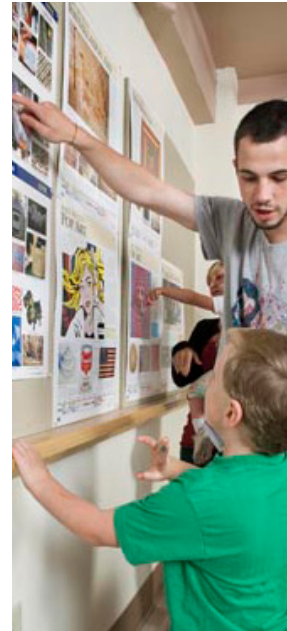
DUAL DEGREE: BFA AND MAT

The Dual Degree--our combined BFA and MAT program--provides both degrees in five years, saving students money and getting them into the classroom faster. We also provide students with a unique opportunity to teach in our Youth Arts program. Education students at NHIA gain real world experience through placements in after-school and in-school positions. Students graduate with the skills and qualifications that lead to higher salaries and sought-after positions.
