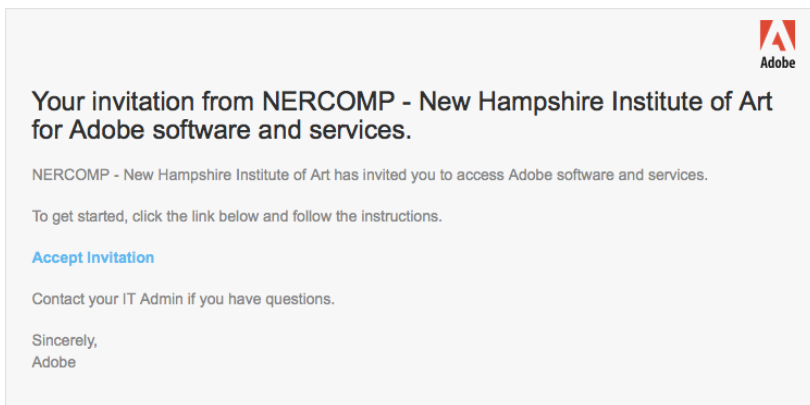
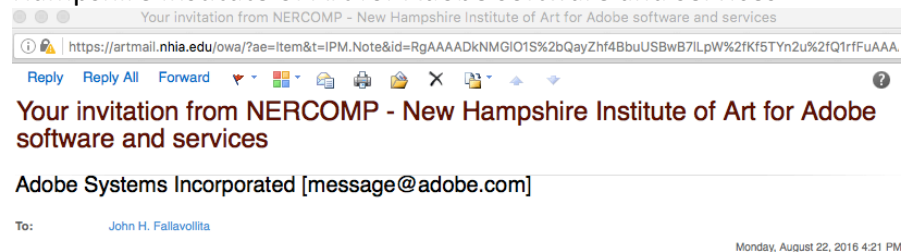


Install the Adobe Creative Cloud on your computer

Note: These instructions require access to your NHIA E-Mail. Documentation for getting into your NHIA email can be found at <http://www.nhia.edu/current-students/technology-support>

The activation process for your Adobe Creative Cloud subscription takes place over two emails. The first is to accept your invitation and the second is to confirm your access.

You will receive an email with the subject line "Your Invitation from NERCOMP – New Hampshire Institute of Art for Adobe software and services"



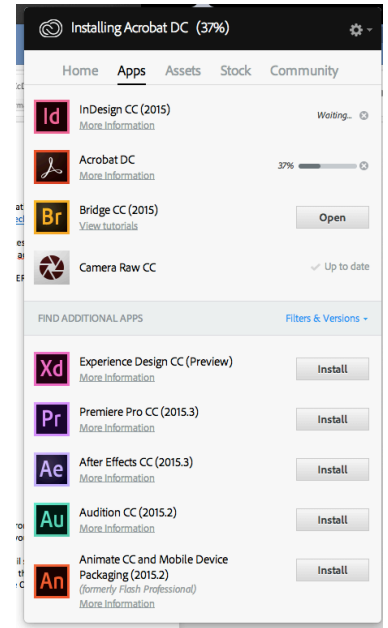
Adobe and the Adobe logo are either registered trademarks or trademarks of Adobe Systems Incorporated in the United States and/or other countries.

Click on the link in the email to activate your subscription. You will be prompted to sign up for an Adobe Creative Cloud account with your NHIA email and a password you create.

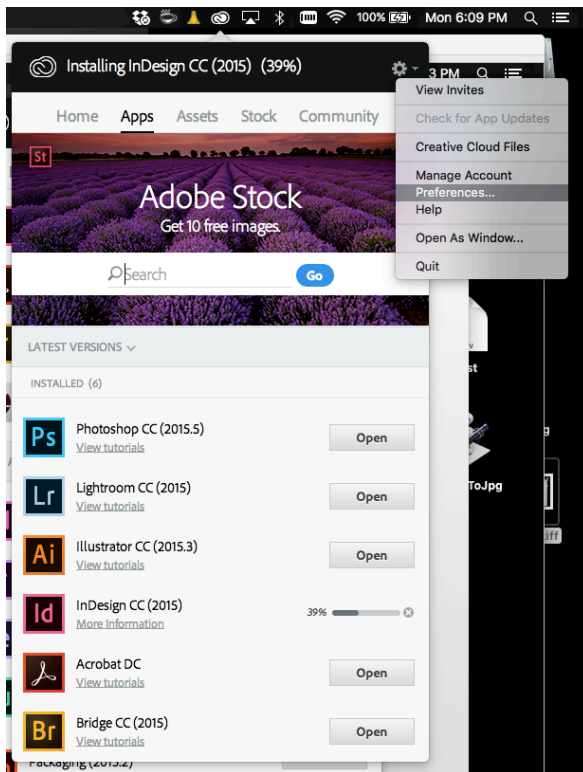
Within approximately 15 minutes you will receive a confirmation email stating that you have access to the Adobe Creative Cloud. There are install links provided in the email but they are difficult to follow. Included below is a direct link to install the Creative Cloud application:

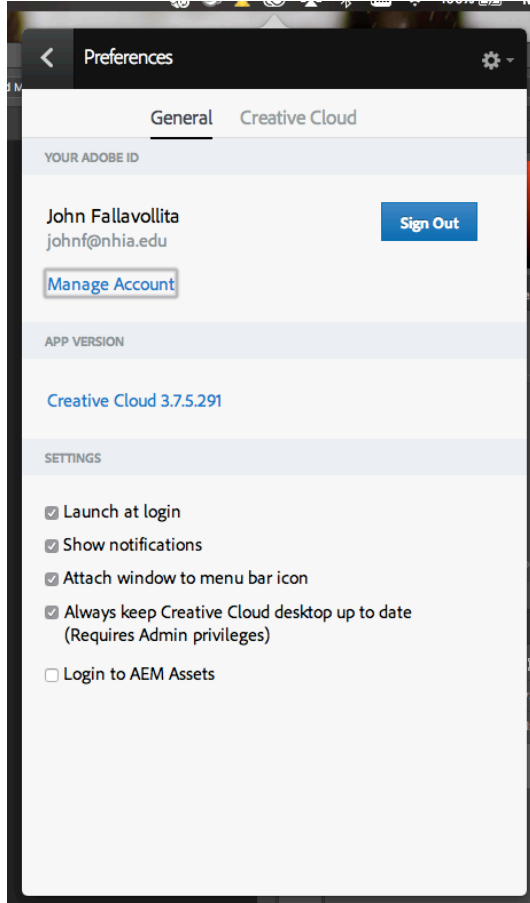

Install the creative cloud application on your computer and login with your NHIA Email address and the password that you created. Click install on any applications you wish to install.



Note: If you already have an NHIA laptop with the Creative Cloud installed, click on the Creative Cloud Icon, then the gear in the top right corner of that window, then Preferences...





Click the Blue “Sign out” button then sign in with your NHIA Email and the password you created in the previous steps.

Note: In our testing we have found the Adobe servers that distribute the Creative Cloud applications to be a bit slow. We heavily suggest to only install the applications you need at first, then later install other applications you may be interested in. Downloading all apps at once will be extremely slow.
