Room needs/Kitchen/Storage

Essential

- Cleaning supplies/dish soap

Essential

- Small first aid kit

Linens Supplies

Essential

- Sheets (XL Twin)/pillowcases
- Towels/body/hand/face
- Pillows
- Blankets/comforter (XL Twin)

Electronics

Essential

- Smart strip surge protector
- Cellphone/chargers
- Computer/supporting cables
- Ethernet cables
- Electronic/USB storage

Not Essential

- Mini tool kit
- Curtains/Drapes
- Can opener
- Area rug
- Small refrigerator*
- Bike*

Not Essential

- Drying rack
- Fabric softener
- Stain remover
- Iron and Ironing board
- Mini sewing kit
- Lint brush

Not Essential

- Mattress pad

Not Essential

- Portable speakers
- Extension cords
- Headphones
- Camera
- TV

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Toaster
- Microwave
- Hot plates
- Items non-recognized to a UL standard by a nationally recognized testing laboratory
- Halogen lamps
- Candles/incense
- Pets-except non-dangerous fish in a 10 gallon or less tank
- Firearms/weapons including airsoft guns

SPECIAL NOTES

*Refrigerators less than 35" and that draw no more than 1.5 amps of power For sustainability purposes, we suggest one refrigerator per two students.

*Bikes - Some halls, but not all, have outdoor bike rooms to lock up bikes.
